
SEARCH METHODOLOGY


Non-systematic but comprehensive database searching in June 2024 (repeated June 2025) with specialist library support

Medline, CINAHL, PsychINFO and Embase

Handsearching

Grey literature






STUDIES IDENTIFIED

646 screened by abstract using specified criteria

158 full paper reviewed

48 fulfilled criteria

33 used to support guidance

NATURE OF STUDIES FOUND

FROM PEER REVIEWED JOURNALS

Mainly qualitative studies

Surveys

Expert opinion

Observational

Case reports

Often low sample size

BARRIERS PATIENT AND CARER REPORTED

- Awareness of service availability
- Access to DDC- both emergency and routine
- Geographic discrepancies in service provision
- Financial


BARRIERS DENTAL PROFESSIONAL REPORTED



Remuneration

Dentist time/resources

Uncertain financial situation of patients



Service constraints especially since 2006 and 2020



Fear of litigation and 'compromised' care

Medical, consent and social complexities

SKILL MIX AND DDC

Key roles for all members of the dental team...

....but appropriate contractual arrangements and training required

Therapists experienced in SCD can provide up to 53% of care for care home residents

~ 11% need SCD specialist care

LOOKING FORWARD

- Need for flexible commissioning
- Combined working between NHS GDPs, CDS, hospital care and private sector
